- over 129 compact fluorescent light bulbs
- 8 new energy star appliances

YMCA applied for the **saveONenergy HOME ASSISTANCE** Program and received **FREE** energy-efficient upgrades for their members. YWCA Sudbury is a charitable non-profit organization that provides services to women and their families since 1958.

YWCA Sudbury operates Geneva House, a 32 bed shelter for women and children escaping intimate partner abuse, and Brookwood Apartments, a 10 unit apartment building for women and their children. This building is 100% rent-geared-to-income subsidized by the City of Greater Sudbury Housing Services.

Total Savings:

- approximately \$1,727.99 annual savings on whole shelter's electricity bill
- 11,755 kWh annual savings
